Flathead County Cost-of-Living Figures For First Quarter 2008 Released

Information released by the Kalispell Chamber of Commerce revealed that Flathead County cost-of-living is 1.4% above the national average.

The Flathead County cost-of-living index measures differences between areas in the cost of consumer goods and services, excluding taxes and non-consumer expenditures. It is based on 59 items, for which prices are collected quarterly by the Kalispell Chamber of Commerce throughout Flathead County. Local data is combined with information from 292 other communities to create the ACCRA Cost of Living Index. ACCRA is the national association of community and economic research professionals. Other Montana areas participating in the survey include Bozeman and Missoula. The ACCRA Cost-of-Living Index for the Kalispell area during the first quarter of
